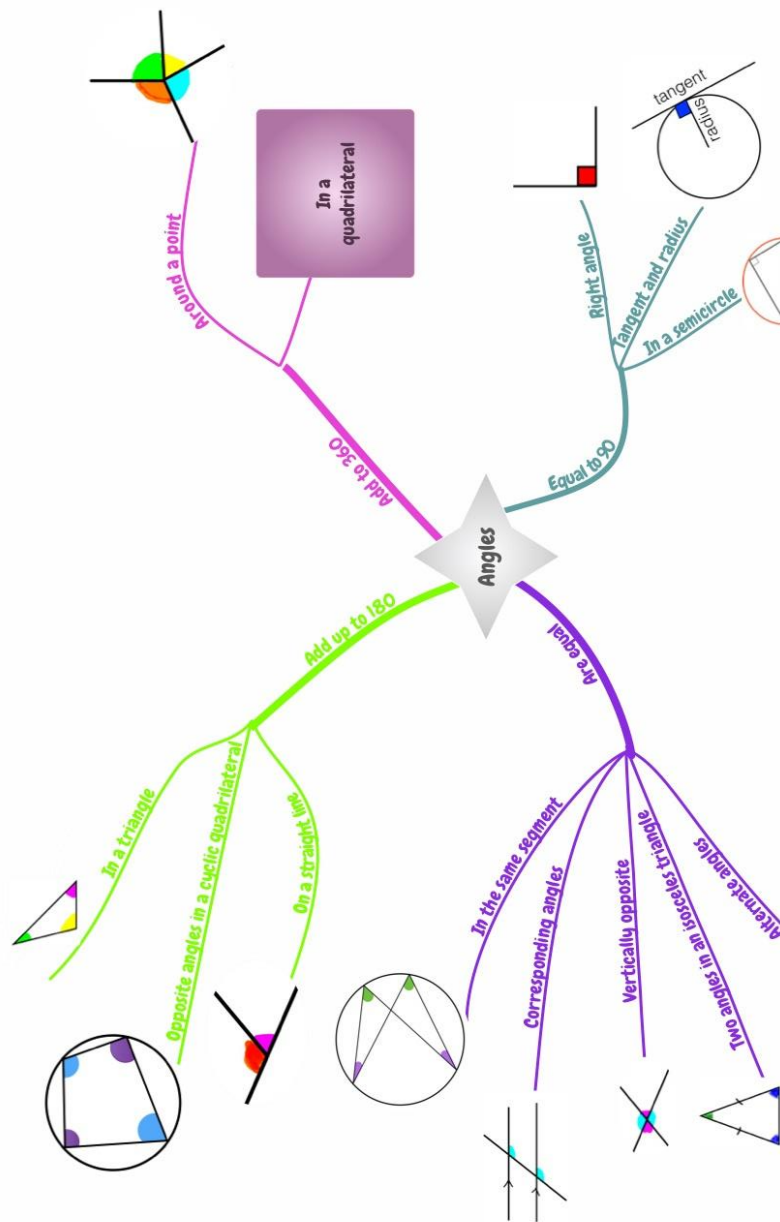


Y7 Maths Weekly Task Grid – Week commencing 4th May
