Read your parent's favourite book/story from when they were younger- Write a simple book review of the book.

Read a chapter of your book and write a letter/email to the main character telling them your thoughts about the events in that part of the book.

Imagine you are in the setting of the story you are reading, write a postcard home telling them all about where you are.
