PE Lessons

Current Government guidance is advising against the using of changing rooms in preparation for physical activity. Bearing this in mind, added to the small size of the changing rooms at school, there will be some changes in how PE lessons will operate.

Starting Monday 14 September 2020, students will be required to attend school in their full PE kit for the duration of the day when they have a PE lesson. They will therefore not be required to wear their normal school uniform on the days they have a PE lesson.

To ensure students only wear their PE kit on the correct days, they will be given a sticker to place on the back of their ID cards/in their planners to highlight the days they have PE lessons.

Students must ensure that they adhere to the PE kit policy which has been detailed below.

- **Stocksbridge High PE Shirt**
- **Stocksbridge High Hoody** (Not compulsory wear for every PE lesson, but this will be the only outerwear accepted during PE lessons)
- **Black Shorts/Tracksuit Bottoms/Sport specific leggings** (Small logos/motifs only)
- **Appropriate trainers** (Not Plimsoles or Pumps)

Additional Guidance

- Where a student doesn't have a PE hoody, they may choose to wear a long sleeve t-shirt or base-layer underneath their PE t-shirts.
- Students may still wear outer clothing to and from school, but will need to remove this once in school as per normal school uniform policy.
- If students do not have a school PE hoody, they may wear their normal school jumper whilst they are in their other lessons throughout the day. Other sporting jumpers/hoodies will not be permitted during lessons.
- As students will remain in their PE kits throughout the day, every effort will be made by staff to ensure that students will remain indoors for lessons during wet weather conditions.
