



Sheffield Y11 Activity Survey: Stocksbridge High School

Data collated and quality assured by Participation & Progression Team, Children & Young People Performance & Analysis Service, supported by Community Youth Teams. National data supplied by the Department for Education National Client Caseload Information Team.

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This annual survey aims to establish young people's education, employment and training destinations on the 1st of November, in the year they completed compulsory education.

The Y11 Activity survey should not be confused with the Key Stage 4 Destination Measures; whilst both focus on the same cohort (Y11 leavers), the methodologies differ. The Activity Survey provides a snapshot at a census point, whilst the Ks4 destination measures are based on sustained destinations over a period of time.

Coverage - The Y11 Activity Survey covers all young people who reached the compulsory school leaving age in 2025 and were educated in schools or other institutions in the Local Authority (LA) area on 31 May 2025. At LA level, the survey also includes young people resident in the LA area who were not enrolled at a school, including those receiving home tuition.

Data reference period - The date of the reported activity is **1st November 2025**. It is expected that by this time young people will have made firm decisions about further education.

Conduct of the survey - Information on activity status is sought from education and training institutions in the first instance. Those not covered by institutional information or where inadequate information has been obtained have been surveyed directly by LA services. LA services have attempted to identify the activity of those who have moved out of the area since completing Year 11, working with other LAs where appropriate.

Comparator pupil groups - Pupil characteristics are taken from the LA school pupil database as at 31 May. Schools are given the opportunity to confirm their cohort as part of the checking exercise. All elements include comparison to the Local Authority average, which is displayed in red. National data is usually available the summer following the activity survey. Trend data shows latest available national information.

Activity Categories - Into Learning is the headline success measure that identifies the proportion of young people that have progressed into destinations that include an element of learning, which is a requirement for those under 18 (RPA). The sub-categories of Into Learning are:

Full Time Education - includes those attending an education institution designated as a school or college by the DfE.

Training - any other Full Time Education generally delivered by private training providers (not including Apprenticeships).

Apprenticeships - young people on a government funded Apprenticeship scheme.

Employment with Training - full time employment that includes work towards a regulated qualification, not including Apprenticeships.

The remaining categories are -

Employment without Training - any full time Employment where a young person is not also undertaking a regulated qualification.

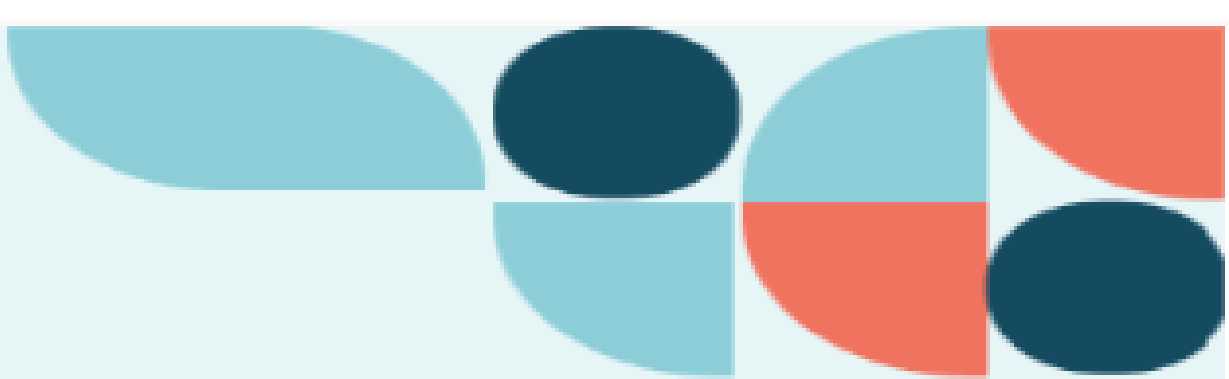
NEET - Active includes those in part time or temporary Employment, or voluntary work and those seeking education employment or training.

NEET - Not Active includes young people who are not able to participate in Education Employment and Training, including those who are ill, pregnant or have full time caring responsibilities (e.g) parents.

Not known - where destinations could not be identified, including young people known to have moved away but where their activity could not be established in their new place of residence.

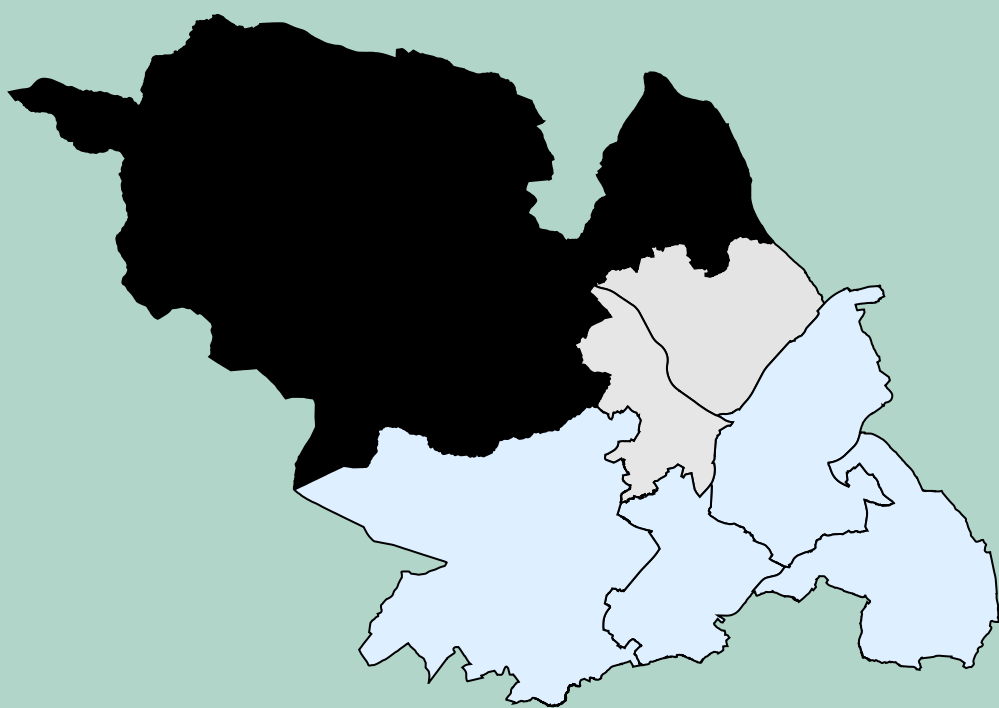

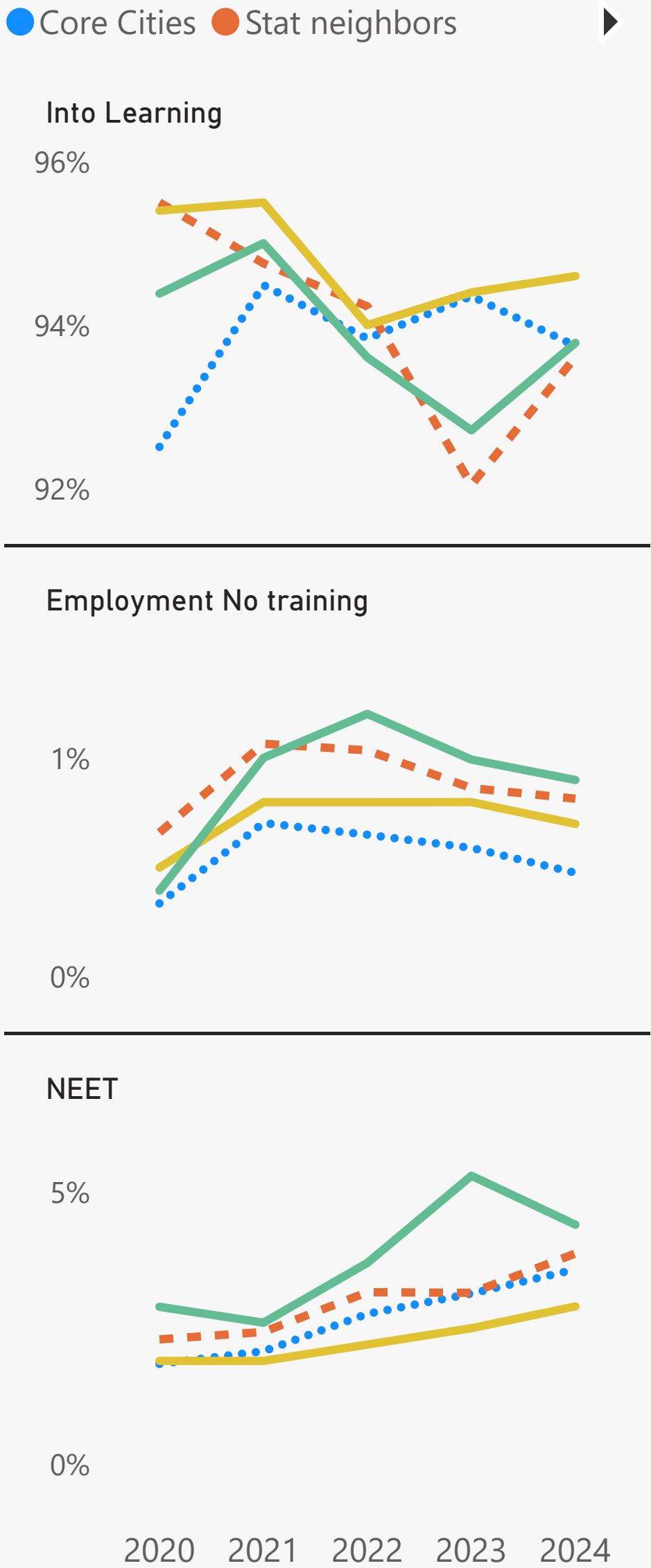
