On **Wednesday 15 October 2025**, we are hosting our annual Post-16 Evening at Stocksbridge High School, from 6.00pm to 8.00pm. This evening is open to all **parents/carers AND students** in Year 10 and Year 11. During this evening, information will be presented from a range of Post-16 options in the form of 20-minute presentations from different providers.

We are glad to be able to offer in-school and face-to-face opportunities for you to gather information and get support for your child through Key Stage 4 (KS4). Post-16 providers that have been invited include Sheffield and Barnsley Colleges, Sheffield Futures, Penistone Grammar Sixth Form School, SWFC, Chapeltown Academy and Notre Dame High School.
